

SCOTT BURDICK WORKSHOP MATERIALS LIST

This list is not exclusive. Bring the materials and particular colors that suit you best. The important concepts to be covered are drawing, value, edges, and color and will apply no matter what the medium, or various brands.

Oils (Windsor Newton. No hues.)

1. Cadmium Yellow
2. Cadmium Lemon
3. Cadmium Red
4. Permanent Rose
5. Viridian
6. Cobalt Blue
7. Ultramarine Blue
8. Ivory Black
(Rembrandt brand)
9. Transparent Oxide Red
10. Titanium White

For a support:

Scott uses Clausen's double primed Belgium linen - medium or portrait texture.

Use your best judgment.

Watercolors (Windsor Newton or Rembrandt) Same colors as on the oil palette with a few additions. The oil colors are sufficient to mix any color necessary but in watercolor this is not always possible.

1. Cadmium Yellow
2. Cadmium Lemon
3. Cadmium Red
4. Permanent Rose
5. Viridian
6. Cobalt Blue
7. Ultramarine Blue
8. Ivory Black
(Rembrandt brand)
9. Transparent Oxide Red
10. Titanium White
11. Sap Green
12. Olive Green
13. Burnt Sienna
14. Burnt Umber

For a support:

1. cold pressed boards
2. heavy weight papers (140lb and up)
3. bristol board.

Pastels – Scott uses both Rembrandt and Sennelier pastels. Bring all that you use in your work. For a support:

1. watercolor board
2. sand paper
3. pastel paper.

Brushes –

1. Mostly flat and filbert bristles with several long, soft-haired smaller brushes for details. There is no particular brand that he prefers.
2. several different sized palette knives.
3. (Mandatory request) Bring a couple of large bristle brushes, at least a size 12. Scott buys Langnickel or Rosemary brushes.
4. Flat watercolor brushes of various sizes. He uses bristle brushes in his watercolor work with great effects.

NO MEDIUMS!

For thin washes and brush cleaning, it is mandatory to use one of the following compounds:

Odorless Mineral Spirits ---Turpenoid Natural
EcoHouse Neutral thin
Walnut Oil
Gamsol

Scott uses Odorless spirits to clean brushes and to thin down the paint for some initial washes. Most of the time he uses the paint straight.
